

Course Settings:



Course Settings is a completely new panel in Learn Ultra that works similarly to the proprieties section in Original. This panel will have all the configurations for the course, and users with privileges will be able to view/edit different course configuration settings that will be divided into separate sections. Course Duration and Course Tools will be available first.

Properties

- Course Duration
 - With this section, the user can view the set duration of the course. Users with privileges can also change the course duration: set dates, dates of enrollment, continues, and term if the course is associated with a term.
- Course Tools

With this section, the user can set the tools they want the course to use. Course tools will depend on the institution/node-level policies. This means that even with privileges to view this section, the user can only change a specific tool if the institution has decided that that tool is mandatory for the course.


First tools that will be available in the Course Tools section:

- Roster: This will turn off/on roster for student (available in July)
- Messages: This will turn off/on messages (available in August)

Course creation:


- Learning Module—Progress tracking and visual appearance
 - When progress tracking is enabled, it will be possible for students to easily track their progress within a learning module without the need to expand it and look at individual items. The progress tracking indicator on the top level of a learning module will draw the student's attention to the number of unopened, started, and completed items. It also offers an easy way to "Start," "Continue," or "See" completed learning modules.

- Basic progress indicator from the student view
- No visual differentiator for each learning module

After:




- Clearer progress indication. Progress bar within each learning module visible to students.
- Descriptive images can be added to each learning module. Provides visual clues to students and improves the experience.
- An easier way to keep working where the student left off. New "start/continue" button.


Content management:

• Batch Edit: Instructors often need to adjust dates in their courses, including after a course copy or conversion. With Batch Edit, instructors can now select all items on the course outline and quickly roll dates forward. Batch Edit now supports recursion. If a folder or learning module is selected, all child items within the folder or learning module receive the update. This is ideal for rolling dates and for removing release conditions by setting items to be hidden or visible to students.
