FOR GROUP LEADERS

How to use this August Action Sheet

CCL volunteers gather each month locally in groups to do four things: Learn, Celebrate, Practice and Act.

Information to share with your volunteers:

- 1. How to use coverage of climate impacts in your media relations. And our new op-ed templates.
- 2. Our no-cost virtual Sept. 15-16 <u>CCL Inclusion Conference</u> (<u>cclusa.org/inclusion</u>) and our free national Nov 4-5 (save the date) <u>CCL Fall Virtual Conference</u>.
- 3. Post-debt ceiling update on <u>Comparing Permitting Reform Proposals</u>.
- 4. CCL Community's Local, State and National Level Policy Engagement training.
- 5. Think of a local community leader who is a <u>trusted messenger to your MOC</u> and could lobby on Zoom with you in November.
- 6. Policy-specific actions are pinned at the top of these four CCL Community sitewide forums: <u>Carbon Pricing</u>, <u>Clean Energy Permitting</u>, <u>Healthy Forests</u>, <u>Building Electrification and Efficiency</u>.

Virtual and in-person town halls provide an opportunity for volunteers to directly engage with their members of Congress in a structured format. Town halls are worth preparing for, so make a plan to **Attend town halls during August recess and bring up climate impacts**.

An effective welcome process ensures new recruits acquire the necessary knowledge, skills, and behaviors to become empowered volunteers. This month, **Tune up your onboarding and welcome new recruits** you've signed up over the summer.

Sample meeting agenda (suggested time is 55-85 minutes)

- 1. To begin your meeting, you might read a statement of CCL values. See this forum post for an example.
- 2. Connection before content. Prompt: What non-CCL activity lights you up? 5 mins
- 3. Celebrate chapter and volunteer successes. 5 mins
- 4. Invite your volunteers to start filling out your copy of the monthly virtual sign-up sheet.
- 5. If attendees heard Ramona Liberoff speak on our monthly call, invite them to share something they learned. If you have a big group and you're on Zoom, use breakouts. *5-10 mins*
- 6. Do the <u>August Climate Action Program action</u> ('cosponsor the TSP Access Act') together. Ask your chapter's Mobilization Manager (designate one if you don't have one) to lead it. <u>cclusa.org/action</u> *5 mins*
- 7. Complete the two actions and two bonus actions on the following pages. 5-10 mins each
- 8. Do the Communications Exercise. 10 mins
- 9. Round-robin share What group or personal action will you take during the next month? 5-10 mins
- 10. Ask someone to log your meeting in the Action Tracker.
