

Save on better appliances: Don't miss out on federal tax credits

Federal tax credits have helped millions of families upgrade to modern, efficient home energy systems that cut bills and improve comfort. But time is running out: **these credits expire on December 31, 2025.**

What households can claim

25C Energy Efficient Home Improvement Credit

- Up to \$3,200 per year for home upgrades.
- 30% of project costs (up to \$1,200) for energy audits, insulation, air sealing, panel upgrades, windows/doors, and more.
- Up to \$2,000 extra for installing a heat pump or heat pump water heater.
- Credits for HVAC and water heating upgrades also apply to secondary residences.

25D Residential Clean Energy Credit

- 30% of project costs (uncapped) for solar panels, battery storage, and other clean energy systems.
- **Note:** With installation timelines often running many months, it may already be too late to start new solar projects and finish them before the deadline.
