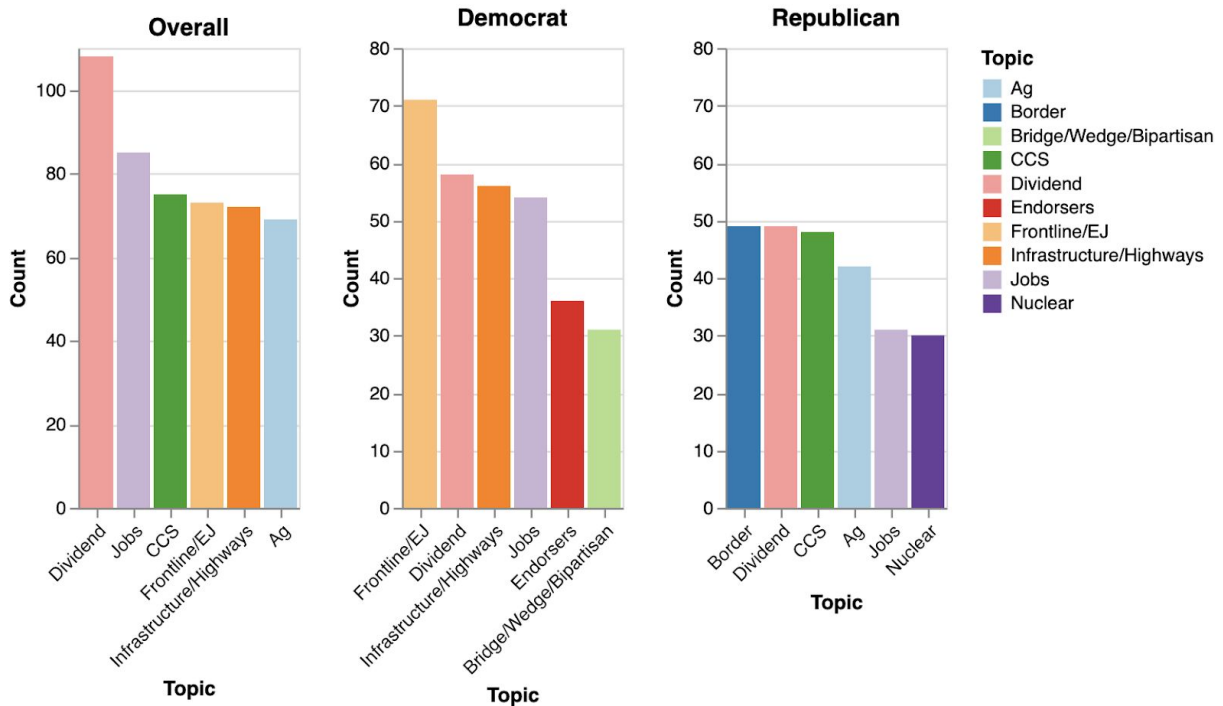
## Findings: 434 Congressional Meetings, June 2020

### I. What are the most common topics raised in our Congressional meetings?

**Table 1.** The most common topic areas raised by Congress were the Dividend, Jobs, Carbon Capture and Sequestration (CCS), Frontline Communities/Environmental Justice, Infrastructure, and Agriculture.

**Figure 1.** Looking at top topics for Congress overall can mask important priorities for Democratic and Republican offices, respectively. Top 6 topics by party depicted below. These are based on the same data as seen in Table 1, depicted differently.



**Figure 2.** Each map visualization below represents how often a topic was raised by a Member of Congress/Staffer in a meeting for each CCL region. Topics were only counted if it was brought up by the Member of Congress/Staffer (not if it was just mentioned by a CCL volunteer). Darker blue indicates higher percentage of offices bringing up the topic in that region. Lighter yellow indicates lower percentages. Each of the topics below was a top ten topic for Congress overall.
