

Setting up your personal journal

You need to set up your journal before you can start making entries to it.

Name of journal: Give your journal a title. If you can't think of something now, use your screen name.

Description: Provide a short description of the purpose of your journal, or maybe a little bit about yourself

Add journal image: Is there a particular picture you want to use on the front page of your journal?

Add users to journal: Would you and a friend like to contribute posts to the same journal? Add them here. You can only add your community friends.

Include an external RSS Feed: Do you already have a blog on a different site? Grab the RSS URL and place it here. When you create in that blog it will appear on CancerConnection.ca also.

Hit 'Save'. Don't worry - you can always go back and edit these items at a later date.

Your journal is now set up and ready to go!
