

ISTAART Ascent Career Development Program

Program Details

- Participants immerse themselves in Alzheimer's and dementia research landscape by attending the Alzheimer's Association International Conference (AAIC) 2026, including:
 - Enjoying a welcome dinner for ISTAART Ascent participants
 - Presenting their work at the world's largest forum for Alzheimer's and dementia research participants
 - Attending poster and podium presentations presented by other ISTAART Ascent participants
 - Acting as judges in the ISTAART Student Poster Competition
- Participants participate in a virtual meeting once every month with other cohort members, hosted by the Alzheimer's Association.
 - Participants must lead at least one peer-to-peer engagement virtual meeting in which they (i) Present a summary of their own work and future plans, (ii) Moderate a Q&A with leaders in the field on a career-development topic. Examples* include:
 - Publishing with editors of the *Alzheimer's and Dementia* journal family
 - Funding with awardees and reviewers of the Alzheimer's Association International Grants Research Program (IRGP)
 - Budgeting with members of the Alzheimer's Association grants team
 - Building collaborative networks with members of the ISTAART Advisory Council (IAC) and Professional Interest Area (PIA) chairs
 - Scientific abstracts and programs with members of the AAIC Scientific Program Committee
 - Building a team and creating an environment of inclusion with the winners of the AAIC and AAIC Neuroscience Next Awards
 - Social media for scientific engagement with the Alzheimer's Association Marketing and Communications team and ISTAART Executives
- Participants work together to submit an ISTAART Educational Event at AAIC 2027 that shares key learnings of the program with a broad audience

- Participants are required to submit an abstract to the AAIC 2026 before the main submission deadline of January 16, 2026.
