- Scissors, Markers, and Recycling Bin if you are setting up new kits
- LEGO® Brick Found container for bricks that become separated from sets
- Student devices for SPIKE™ sets
- Power Strips or Charging Station for SPIKE™ Hubs

Step Three: Setting Up SPIKETM Hubs!

LEGO® Education SPIKETM Essential and LEGO® Education SPIKETM Prime kits contain a motor brick Hub that will need some preparation prior to use.

- Before the first camp session, be sure to charge each of the Hubs and set up a charging station in your activity area. If students connect via Bluetooth, be sure to charge the SPIKETM hubs each day.
- Be sure to update Hub firmware, if needed.
- Determine whether student devices will use the <u>SPIKETM Webapp</u> or will need to have <u>SPIKETM App downloaded and installed</u>.
