



BOOTH ACTIVITY RULES

While we do encourage you to continue thinking of innovative ways to engage with attendees on the exhibit floor, we also are required to maintain the parameters outlined in your exhibit contract.

Lotteries, Contests/Games, Drawings and Giveaways

The operation of games of chance or lottery devices, or the actual or simulated pursuit of any recreational past time is permitted only with written approval from NIGP.

Noise and Odors

Noisy or obstructive work will not be permitted during open hours of the Exposition, nor will noisily operating displays, nor exhibits producing objectionable odors. NIGP shall have sole discretion in determining what is noisy, obstructive or objectionable. Sound within a booth may not exceed 80dB. Sound must be at a level that does not disturb neighboring exhibits (80 decibels when measured by NIGP Exposition Management from any adjacent aisle) and presentations must be done in a manner that does not encourage congregation of attendees in the aisles.

All Booth Activities Require Written Approval

All booth activities require written approval by Show Management by **July 24, 2026**. If written approval was not granted by Show Management by the deadline, NIGP reserves the right to shut down booth activities in their entirety onsite. Your booth activities and giveaways will remain confidential.
