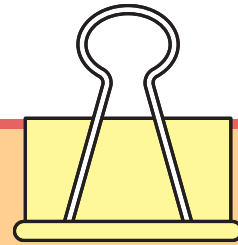
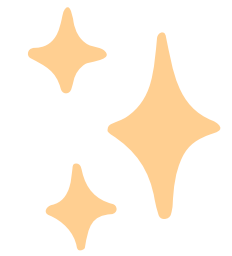

Exploration and Exposure to Work



Pre-ETS

- 5 tailored services (age 14)
 1. Job Exploration Counseling
 2. Work Readiness Training
 3. Instruction in Self-Advocacy
 4. Counseling in Post-Secondary
 5. Work Based Learning
- VR / ED coordination



Education

- Most trusted connection to student & family
- Connect student & family with adult agencies; help navigate waitlists
- Ed goals determine graduation date; ends at age 21 or sooner



VR

- WIOA requires 15% of VR budget; 42 states expended in 2022
- May be “Presumed Eligible”; no VR application required
- Greatest indicator of CIE success is paid work experience in HS
